Method of booking and payment

Participants book and pay for their accommodation themselves (on site or in advance according to the pro forma invoice). Accommodation reservations must be made no later than May 12, 2025 via email: info@hotel-kolovare.com with a note for the conference 33rd International Summer School of Kinesiology. After May 12, 2025, accommodation availability on request.

Cancellation policy

In the event of cancellation, Hoteli Zadar d.d. (Hotel Kolovare) will charge the guest a cancellation fee according to the following conditions:

45 days before arrival / Hoteli Zadar d.d. will not charge the guest for the cancellation of the reservation

44 – 30 days before arrival / Hoteli Zadar d.d. will charge 30% of the total amount

29 – 14 days before arrival / Hoteli Zadar d.d. will charge 50% of the total amount

13 – 7 days before arrival / Hoteli Zadar d.d. will charge 75% of the total amount

6 – 1 day before arrival / Hoteli Zadar d.d. will charge 90% of the total amount

NO SHOW and cancellation of the reservation on the day of arrival

Hoteli Zadar d.d. will charge 100% of the total amount of the booked stay at the hotel.

Cancellation of individual reservations within a group:

10 – 5 days before arrival / Hoteli Zadar d.d. will not charge the agency for up to 5% of the cancelled contracted capacity. The remaining cancelled capacity will be charged in full.

3 or less days before arrival / all cancelled rooms will be charged in full according to the cancellation conditions

Cancellation compensation is calculated as a percentage of the total value of the booked services.

In the case of a NO SHOW (group or individual), Hoteli Zadar d.d. reserves the right to charge the full amount of the ordered service.

The above conditions do not apply to persons who are unable to use the reservation due to covid infection, for them we approve cancellation 24 hours before arrival with confirmation without charging penalties.
